## **President-Elect 2023**



The President is elected one year before he/she takes office. During that year, he/she serves as **President-Elect**, and will be a supernumerary member of the Executive Committee if not already a member.

## **Duties**

As a Society Officer, together with the other Officers, the **President** has Power of Signature for the Society. The Society **President** leads the strategic development of the Society's activities, including;

- Participation in face-to-face meetings (3 per year) & virtual calls with the Executive Committee (3 per year), plus monthly calls with the Administrative office
- With the other Society Officers, responsibility to plan the Society's annual budget, supervise the Society's Administrative Office's handling of Society's finances
- Participation in the Society's General Assembly at Congress
- Collective responsibility for the Society's finances with other Executive Committee members

## Ideal candidate profile

- Committed and active member of EAS and should have regularly attended EAS meetings
- Good understanding of EAS structure and function, by having served on the EAS Executive Committee
- Internationally well-known and actively involved in research in the atherosclerosis field
- Excellent scientific record
- Good connections and working relations with major players in the field at international level (scientific societies, pharmaceutical companies etc.)
- Good communication skills
- Must be prepared to work closely with the EAS Vice President
- Should have a high degree of commitment to prepare and attend Executive Committee meetings
- Should not have any potential conflict of interest with other international societies
